Colonial Gaiters

Gaiters were a constant in colonial military or frontier dress. Introduced in 1701 during the Queen Anne's War, they became more essential during the French and Indian War when frontier campaigns and exposure to Native Americans tribes became more prevalent. The book <u>Daily Life of the Old</u> <u>Colonial Frontier</u> describes the private soldier during this time as wearing (among other things) "..one pair of gaiters made of canvass, one water-resistant pair made of linen canvass and blackened with tar, and one pair of black woolen cloth". Our gaiters are made from wool and measure 24" long and enclosed on the outer edge by white bone buttons.



Brass & Copper Lanterns

Brass and copper lanterns were also prevalent throughout the 18th and early 19th century. We offer two styles in brass.
