## 18<sup>TH</sup>-19<sup>TH</sup> Century Style Powder Horns



### A York County Style Screw-Tip Powder Horn

This fine horn is based on those typically made in the York County, Pennsylvania area in the late 18th and early 19th century. Ours feature lathe-turned, screw-off wooden tips and stoppers for easy filling and beehive style base plugs all made of nicely figured hardwood similar to walnut. The 3/4" leather shoulder strap slips over the wood tip and is then secured to the base with a hand forged iron staple. 10" to 14" in length.

### B Engrailed & Carved Powder Horn

This is a traditional horn with the features typical of so many originals of the French & Indian War through the Revolutionary period. Most notable are the engraved (scalloped) edge at the base of the carved neck and spout, flat base plug secured with brass nails and decorative, incised lines around the base and neck. Furnished with a latigo leather shoulder strap secured with hand forged iron staples. 10" to 14" in length.

Another nice touch is a double strap ring on the carved neck, and the horn itself has a pleasing antique satin finish. 10" - 14".


