# **Czech Seed Beads**

For loomwork, appliqué, edge beading, etc., these beads are highly preferred due to their uniformity of shape and size as well as the wide range of colors available. Strung beads are better quality, more uniform in size and easier to use than loose beads, so you will have fewer "culls" with these. Be sure to order plenty of beads in your background color as dye lots can have slight variations in color, even in white, so they may not match perfectly. Prices are for one color per kilo or 1/2 kilo and we recommend specifying a second choice if possible. Hanks are 24 strings 10" long. 2 strings = 1 loop.


